Follow Up

The Advanced Practice Nurses in ostomy care services; Jan Colwell, Malou De Ocampo or Michele Kaplon-Jones should see you at least twice after surgery in the outpatient clinic. These visits are used to evaluate the current management system, assess the stoma, the skin and to address adjustment issues. More visits can be scheduled as necessary. It is advisable for a person with a permanent stoma to have a yearly visit to see the ostomy nurse. This visit is used to check the health of the stoma and the skin around the stoma, to evaluate the ostomy pouching system and to review aspects of living with a stoma. To make an appointment call the outpatient clinic scheduling office at 773-834-3524. Visits to the Advanced Practice Nurse in ostomy care are handled at the Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM) Building, 6A.
